

MEMBERSHIP LEAVING CODES

<u>CODE</u>	<u>REASON</u>	<u>MARK BOOK OF CONSTITUTIONS AND REGULATIONS</u>	<u>NOTES</u>
R	Resignation (from the Lodge)	B.C.R. Rule 115	The Brother voluntarily chooses for personal reasons to resign his membership of the Lodge.
D	Deceased		
H	Elected to H onorary Membership (of the Lodge)	B.C.R. Rule 112	The Brother technically resigns as a subscribing member of the Lodge to take up Honorary Membership.
T	Elected to become Tyler (of the Lodge)	B.C.R. Rule 113	The Brother becomes a member of the Lodge but immediately resigns to become the paid Tyler of the Lodge. He may apply to become a subscribing re-joining member of the Lodge at any time in the future.
C	Ceased (Membership of the Lodge)	B.C.R. Rule 118	The Brother has not paid his annual dues to the Lodge for two years.
E	Excluded (by the Lodge)	B.C.R. Rule 117	The Brother has not paid his annual dues and the Lodge By-Laws allow for such an exclusion, following a resolution and a vote by members. Alternatively he has been excluded by the Lodge for some other reason following a resolution by the members.

W	Warrant Surrendered		The Lodge Warrant has been surrendered
S	Suspended (from membership of the Lodge)	B.C.R. Rule 139	Although suspended from membership of the Lodge, the Brother continues to pay his annual subscription to the Lodge; and the Lodge continues to pay Annual Dues on his behalf to Grand Lodge.
X	Expelled (from the Order by Grand Lodge) for disciplinary Reasons	B.C.R. 140 (ii)	The Brother concerned has been the subject of a disciplinary inquiry and as a consequence expelled from the Order.
V	Voluntary Resignation	U.G.L.E. Rule 183	The Brother has exercised his right to resign from the Order for a variety of possible reasons, including those associated with his employment. Grand Lodge should be contacted at the appropriate time for clarification if the circumstances of the Brother concerned change and he expresses a wish to re-join.

It should be noted that, although the Constitutions and Regulations of Mark Grand Lodge are quoted throughout, the same conditions apply mutatis mutandis to the other Orders administered from Mark Masons' Hall.
